We all cringe when we see a pet outside in our frigid temperatures. If you see a problem with a pet outdoors, call your local law enforcement center. Pets must have access to shelter, food, and non-frozen water at all times. Many pets die well outside when they are housed properly, but don't hesitate to call law enforcement if the pet is struggling. You can remain anonymous.
